

is introducing its first Fire & Ice Festival with an outdoor ice rink. Runs Nov 24th-Jan 1st. **FREE:** Go see the lighted trees floating on the bay. Least busy nights will be Mondays & Tuesdays - because the festival isn't happening then, but the bay will be lit up. Park for under 30 minutes and it's free. (30 minutes to 2 hours is \$10). Dana Point Harbor Lights is a festive light display all around the businesses. FREE: See the lights any night now through mid-January. (If you can, support some of the businesses by getting a cocoa or ice cream — or dine at Happy Hour).

Holidayz at the Park at the Great Park Palm Court Arts Complex is a lightscape display in Irvine. FREE: Wander around the festive lights at night. Opening event is Dec 2nd running through Jan 7th.



Snoopy House at Costa Mesa City Hall has a themed light display, but also free nightly events. Only runs Dec 15th-22nd.
